Intrigued, Fox attended an AA meeting at which she met Marty Mann, who was in recovery and somewhat an anomaly as a woman in the then predominantly male AA. The rest, as they say, is history. The fateful meeting between these two pioneering women, Fox and Mann, would ultimately lead to the creation in 1944 of the National Committee for Education on Alcoholism (NCEA) and in 1954 of the New York City Medical Society on Alcoholism (NYCMSA). From there, the book traces the early roots of what would become ASAM through its many iterations:
